

Summer Covid Recovery Premium update. 6/6/2022

CWA Buckinghamshire campuses were allocated a total of £25,520 as a 'COVID-19 Recovery Fund', based on Pupil Premium numbers. This fund is delivered in four equal payments; to date we have received two of these, totalling £12,760.

This has been accessed by all three Buckinghamshire campuses and has contributed towards our already successful Holiday Clubs. So far, £6,394 has been allocated towards providing food, taxis, and staff salaries. It is anticipated that further contributions from the Recovery Fund will be made in the summer term.

1-1 Tutoring has also taken place after school to help identified students bridge gaps in their learning. Qualified staff have been paid additionally to provide 1-hour sessions over the autumn and spring terms. The school receives a dedicated 'School led tutoring fund' to cover the majority of these costs; however, the COVID Recovery Fund is allocated to cover 25%, so far totalling £706.25.

Moving forward, the plan is to allocate the COVID Recovery fund as it has been previously, but with the addition of staff travel expenses (only where staff have had to make home visits to encourage children in to school due to poor mental health, linked to COVID 19); staff training into mental health and resources used to re-engage students in school.

The impact of COVID 19 will be extensive and long lasting for some of our students, therefore the plan is to direct the fund where required and be responsive to need.
